REGULATIONS

1. Short title and commencement-(1) These Regulations may be cited as the Fire and Emergency Service (Fees) Regulations 2011.

(2) These Regulations commence upon the date they are made.

2. Interpretation-(1) In these Regulations, unless the context otherwise requires:

“**National Building Code**” has the same meaning as in section 2 of the Ministry of Works Act 2002;

“**operation services**” means all the work carried out by the Authority to provide for emergency response pursuant to the Act and any other law;

“**safety and prevention services**” means all the work carried out by the Authority to provide for fire suppression and fire prevention pursuant to the Act and any other law;

“**the Act**” means the Fire and Emergency Service Act 2007.

(2) Classes 1 to 10 referred to in the Schedule mean the corresponding classes used in the Classification of Buildings and Structures under the National Building Code.

3. Application - These regulations apply to the payment of fees, by a property owner, for performance of safety and prevention services and operation services by the Authority.

4. Fees - The fees for performance of services pursuant to the Act are prescribed in the Schedule.
